(This shall be a recognised medical qualification when granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore, Karnataka in respect of students being trained at A.J. Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalore, Karnataka on or after May, 2012.

“Master of Surgery(Ophthalmology)”

MS(Ophthalmology)

(This shall be a recognised medical qualification when granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore, Karnataka in respect of students being trained at A.J. Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalore, Karnataka on or after May, 2012.

- Note to all:
1. The recognition so granted to a Postgraduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
 2. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause 4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Postgraduate Course.
